WHY 'THE COMMONS LA'?

In ages past, 'the commons' was a shared space in a city or university where people could gather, cultivate relationships, share their burdens, and celebrate together. At the center of 'the commons' was a vision for the flourishing of the community where all people would benefit.

As a church, the name The Commons LA embodies our hope to seek the flourishing of our city for all people. Yet The Commons LA isn't so much about a shared space bound by walls, but a shared community bound together by the love of our redeeming God. This community forms a web of relationships centered on the living Jesus, the only source for the flourishing we all desire.

In the gospel* we have the joy-bringing news that unites us: God is at work in our world renewing all that's not the way He created it to be. We get to partner in that work together!

^{*}The gospel is the announcement that God has come to restore us to Himself: that anyone can have new life now by trusting Jesus for their reconciliation with God.

This verse is at the center of who we are:

"For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: one has died for all, therefore all have died: and He died for all, that those who live would no longer live for hemselves, but for Him who for their sake died and was raised.


THE WESTWOOD REGION

As The Commons LA, we exists to primarily reach the region of Los Angeles that is chiefly influenced by UCLA- Westwood & West LA. Our community blends the urban city with a top global university, UCLA, which attracts more applicants per year than any other and is also the largest non-government employer in LA. The ethnic, generational, and socio-economic diversity of this region along with the educational environment presents a unique opportunity for the gospel's advance locally and globally into other urban university settings.

PEOPLE FOCUS

We believe that lasting influence in an urban university region must hold the tension of doing two things well:

1) reach the long-term residents of the community, namely, professionals and families, and 2) be an equipping church home for those involved with the university (undergrad, grad students, residents, & researchers) to belong as family, participate in mission, grow as leaders, and be sent out across the world.

Embrace Diversity

As the people of God in a city like Los Angeles, we should be a diverse community: no single ethnicity, generation, political party, or socioeconomic standing defines us or what we do.

We need those who are different than us to see, enjoy, and reflect the beauty of our diverse God together- so we actively look to defer from the majority for the sake of the whole.

Build Toward Movement

Jesus invites us to participate with Him through intentional efforts to equip leaders, multiply communities, plant gospel-centered churches, and celebrate sending disciples into the next chapter God's Spirit has for them.





DEVOTION + DEPENDENCE

Our first (and most important) philosophy is that of devotion to Jesus and dependence on the Holy Spirit. The Scriptures are filled with examples and instruction on our need for the good news of God's love every day!

We seek to live out such devotion and dependence by striving in everything we do to first pray and look to the Scriptures, trusting God's Spirit to guide us. (Deuteronomy 8; 1 Corinthians 10; John 6:22-59; Philippians 4:4-7)

TEAM LEADERSHIP

We joyfully embrace Scripture's teaching that the church community is to be served by a plurality of qualified leaders (elders and deacons) with diversity in personalities, gifts, and perspectives. We believe that the chief aim of any team of elders is to "equip the saints for the work of ministry" (Ephesians 4), so we count it a 'win' when ministry is led by non-elders who are gifted, godly, and equipped to serve well. We are always looking to create opportunities and multiply leaders.

Note – In the early stages of the church, we have an external board of pastors from other local LA churches who share in the oversight of the The Commons LA's leadership and finances until elders are raised up within the church.

MISSION


The dominant pattern for loving our city in the Scriptures is twofold: invest in the well-being of others and invite others into our lives (Jer 29:4-7; Matt 5:13-16). That means we look for ways to invest through serving & generosity toward our neighbors, coworkers, and friends while inviting them into community, to our various gatherings (Sundays, Social Gatherings, service projects), and most importantly- we invite them to Jesus!



STEWARDSHIP

Scripture is clear: everything we have-time, treasure, talents, & influence- are from God for us to use for His glory and our joy, through participation in His mission. We encourage everyone who calls The Commons LA their church family to give sacrificially (you feel it), regularly (monthly, bi-weekly, etc), and a percentage of their income to the church. You can give through the Pushpay app (search "The Commons LA") or via check/cash on Sunday at the giving table.

Giving & the "Tithe"

While the 'tithe' (giving 10% to the your income to the temple) is no longer mandated in the Christian life, the scriptures assume a kind of foundational generosity patterned after the tithe as a response to God's generosity to us (Luke 11:42). Let's put it this way: If we have received more of God's revelation and grace than those of the Old Testament, our generosity should look more grace-empowered than Old Testament believers, not less so!



BUDGET

Stewarding for faithful gospel ministry

Budgets are theological documents. They express what we believe, showing us what our hearts truly value since they show us where we invest resources in order to see fruitfulness.

God's mission takes money. There's no way around it. Money is needed to bless our community in tangible ways, to put on events that engage the community with the gospel, and for paid staff that can equip the church for growth, joy, and endurance on God's mission. Below you'll find our prayer goals for giving and general budget guidelines.
